Haiku Vineyards specializes in growing organic wine grapes in Mendocino County. We employ the best traditional viticulture techniques combined with sustainable practices to ensure consistent quality. Haiku Vineyards assists wineries to produce fine wine by delivering balanced fruit with pure flavors.

The 210-acre estate vineyard is located along the east side of the Russian River and the west side of the Mayacamas Mountains in the Sanel Valley of Mendocino County, approximately nine miles north of Old Hopland. With nearly one mile of river frontage, the diverse riparian and terrestrial habitats nurture abundant wildlife and enhance the beauty of the location. In the winter, steelhead trout return to spawn in Morrison Creek, which is located on the property. The vineyard consists of 141 acres of Chardonnay, 21.5 acres of Sauvignon Blanc, and 2.5 acres of Syrah.

All blocks of the vineyard have been farmed organically with sustainable viticulture practices since they were planted. Organic farming practices allow for the ultimate expression of terroir because they minimize alteration of the natural environment. An integrated farming approach emphasizes cultural practices (such as canopy management, water management, organic compost, and natural habitats) over material inputs; this ensures healthy, rich soils and balanced vines. Cover crops attract beneficial insects for a natural approach to pest management rather than pesticides. Cover crops also help prevent erosion, retain moisture, and provide organic matter to the soil. Weeds are controlled by mowing and cultivation rather than herbicides. Nesting boxes have been installed around the property for barn owls which provide rodent control and for songbirds which provide insect control.

The trellis system on Chardonnay-Blocks A, B, C and D (clone 4, AXR-1) is 8x10 spacing on 2-wire "California-T," while the trellis system on the Chardonnay-Block E (clone 76, S-04) is 7x8 spacing on a vertical shoot position (VSP) trellis. The Syrah-Block F (Estrella River, 140-R) is 7x8 spacing on a VSP trellis while the trellis system on Chardonnay-Block G and Sauvignon Blanc -Block H 6x8 spacing on a VSP.

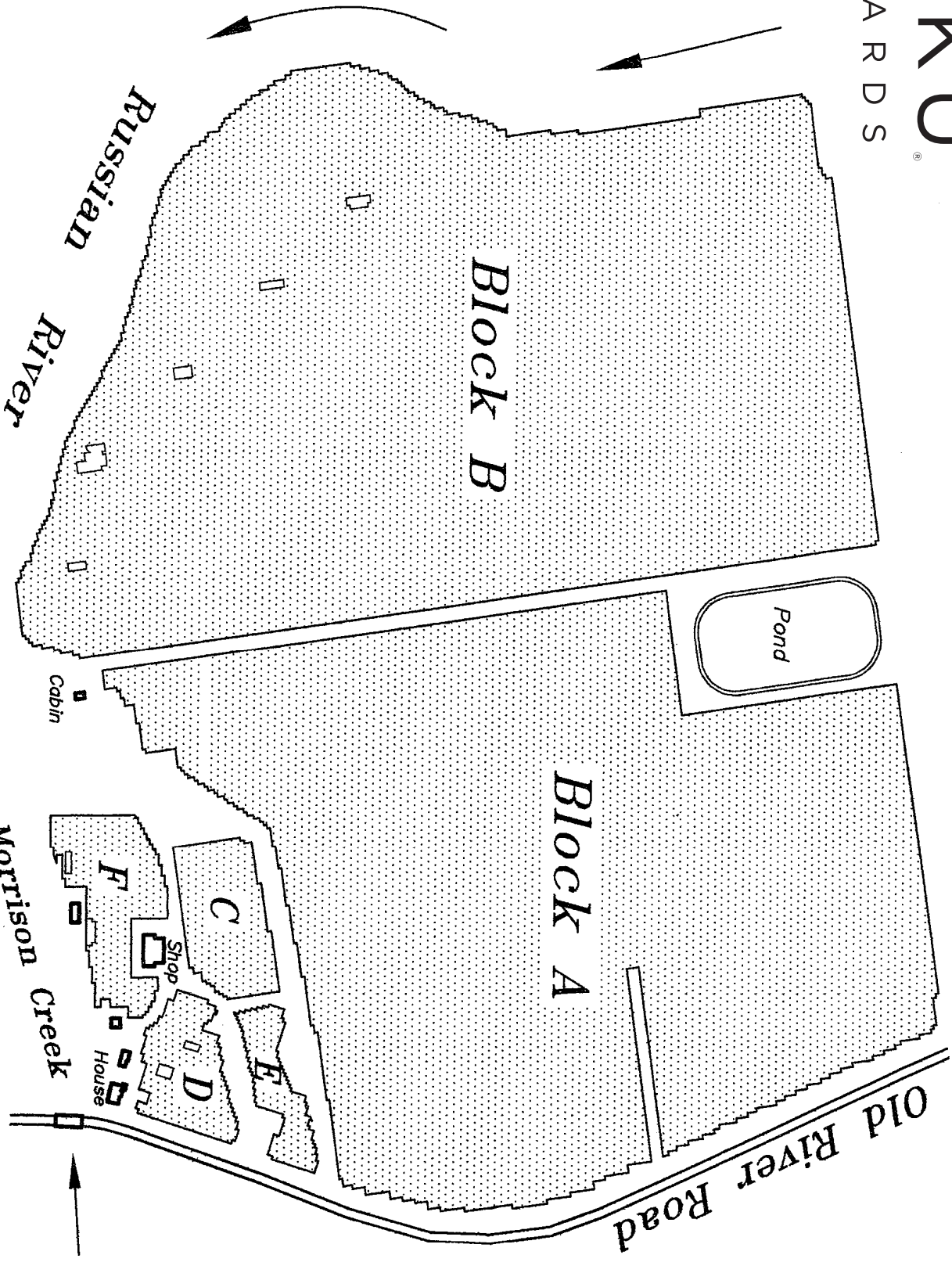
The property has ample water with well-established riparian and appropriative water rights from almost one mile of frontage along the Russian River. An overhead system for frost protection and drip irrigation system are fed from the Russian River, two wells and two reservoirs totaling 50-acre feet. In the winter, steelhead trout return to spawn in Morrison Creek, which is located on the property.

In 2005, the vineyard was certified by the Fish Friendly Farming Certification Program for improving water quality and protecting wildlife habitat. It has since been recognized by Trout Unlimited, the California Land Stewardship Institute, the U.S. House of Representatives, and both Houses of the California Legislative for its continuing efforts to restore and sustain habitat for wild salmon and steelhead trout in the Russian River watershed.

For more than twenty years, organic viticultural practices have further enriched and strengthened the rich loam soils of the site. These healthy soils consistently produce fruit of the highest quality with pure and intense flavors that make excellent wine. Today, the family farming company is managed by the third generation of grape farmers.

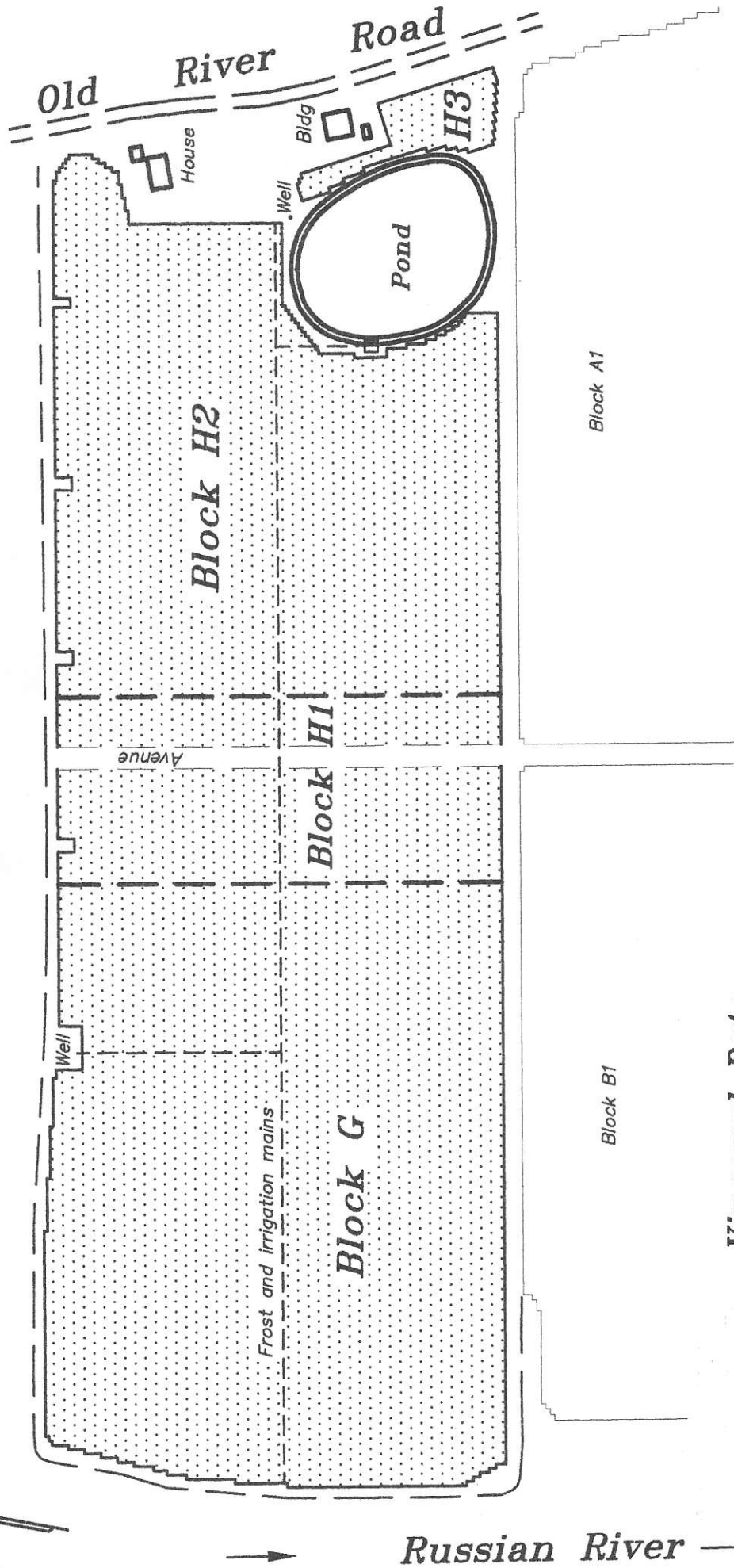
Vineyard Map - Haiku Ranch

- 1) Turn right onto Old River Road
Continue on Old River Road for 1.5 miles
- 2) Turn right onto CA-175 East / East Side 201 Road
Continue on CA -175 for 0.4 mile
- 3) At traffic circle, take the 2nd exit onto Old River Road
Continue on Old River Road for 8.9 miles

US-101 South / Highway 101 South:

- 1) Exit onto CA 222 E / Talmage Road
Continue on Talmage Road for 2.1 miles
- 2) Turn right Old River Road
Continue on Old River Road for 4.0 miles
